As some of you are aware this year 's tournament field is the largest ever as we celebrate the seventh annual Lexi Kretsch Summer Showdown Tournament.

**This year we continuing with our invitational (OPEN) division in the 14U, 16U and 18U age classes of the tournament.**

The intent of this is to ensure that from the start of the tournament to the end your games will be competitive.



The experience in all divisions will be the same great experience you have come to expect, but the invitational will separate those teams who have proven their team is playing at the top of their age group.

The invitational will allow teams to find out how they compete with the best teams this tournament has to offer. Of course, separating these teams into the invitational division should also strengthen the competition and level out the playing field for all other divisions and teams as well.

Teams will be placed into the Lexi Kretsch Invitational by either invite or application. This Invitational (OPEN) Class will be limited in teams.

**Priority for acceptance will be based on (1) team quality, (2) performance in past tournaments, and (3) USSSA points system where appropriate.** Entries will be accepted until April 1<sup>st</sup> 2022 and teams will be notified of their status, via email, by May 1st.
